This is the printable file for all books and series I've ever released. It's designed to be printed on a standard, North American letter-sized page.

Once you've printed it, you can clip, bind, punch and put the stack in a folder, or those snazzy wheel binders... whatever works for you.

I would suggest NOT making the binding permanent. As I release new books, I'll be updating the series pages for that series. You can print off just the series, and replace the older pages, to keep your printed record up to date without having to print *everything*, every time.

Book Lengths

NOVELS AND BOOKS ARE NOT interchangeable terms, although they used to be. When traditional print publishing was the only form of publication, a "novel" was any stand-alone title. In other words, a book.

Now that short stories, novelettes and novellas can be published individually, the meanings of "novel" and "book" have diverged.

Currently, a "book" is any stand-alone title, which might be non-fiction, or fiction of any length except for the shortest of flash fiction.

Ă "novel" is a preset word-count range that defines a story length. Novels are one length of story; there are others.

A "book" was once purely a physical volume that you could hold in your hands. Books could contain a single novel, a collection of novels, (an omnibus), a collection of short stories by different authors (an anthology), a collection of short stories by a single author (a collection), a collection of poems (usually called a volume or sometimes, a chapbook).

The number of pages in a print book was limited by printing processes. The minimum number of pages was in the hundreds of pages. Anything shorter than a novel was never printed on its own in a standalone book. This is why "book" and "novel" became synonymous.

Then ebooks came along and blasted that concept out of the water.

Nowadays, a "book" has become nearly meaningless as a definition, because stories of any length can be published on their own. Print On Demand processes have improved to the point where a book of only 45 pages can be printed as its own volume, which puts longer short stories into the "book" range. It is easier to think of stories and categorize them purely by length.

The official length divisions as given by Wikipedia, the Science Fiction Writers of America and the Romance Writers of America are:

- Short story: under 7,500 words
- Novelette: 7,500 to 17,499 words
- Novella: 17,500 to 39,999 words
- Novel: 40,000 words or over.

Novelettes, which fell out of the traditional publishers' favor when pulp magazines died, are coming back now that indie publishing allows a story to be told in whatever length it needs to be.

Novels, in the pulp fiction era, all hovered around the 40-50K word mark. Then printing became expensive and publishers raised word counts higher and higher each year, to justify the hefty prices they were forced to charge. A 100,000-word book was rare in the mid-20th century but became the norm at the end of the century. Now, novels are returning once more to the tighter, shorter lengths of the range.

For that reason, I put a cap on "novel" length and add an additional length to the definitions:

- Novel: 40,000 to 99,999 words
- Plus-sized novel: 100,000 words or over.

The full list is therefore:

- Flash Fiction: under 1,000 words
- Short story: 1,000 to 7,500 words
- Novelette: 7,500 to 17,499 words
- Novella: 17,500 to 39,999 words
- Novel: 40,000 words to 99,999 words
- Plus-sized novel: 100,000 words or over.



IF YOU'VE NEVER SEEN DIGITAL numbering for series, it can look a little strange. Once you know how it works, you'll find the numbers make sense. They also tell you a lot about the series and the books in them.

For this example, I'm using the Blood Stone series, because it has everything in it; novellas, boxed sets, collections...all of which must be accounted for and at the same time, not confuse readers who are new to the series.

At the moment the series looks like this on all the book pages and the series page:

1:0: Blood Knot

- 1.5: Amor Meus (Collection)
- 2.0: Blood Stone
- 3.0: Blood Unleashed
- 4.0: Blood Revealed
- 5.0: Blood Ascendant
- 5.5: Flesh + Blood (Series boxed set)

Now, if I were to number the series the way Amazon wants me to, using only whole numbers, you'd get:

- 1 Blood Knot
- 2 Amor Meus
- 3: Blood Stone
- 4: Blood Unleashed
- 5: Blood Revealed
- 6: Blood Ascendant
- 7: Flesh + Blood

This is really deceptive! Booksellers usually don't let me add the little descriptors (boxed set, anthology, etc.) that tip you off about the title.

If you read from one book to the other in the order shown above, you wouldn't miss out on anything and you wouldn't get any spoilers in one story about a story you haven't yet read. However, you'd probably feel that book 6, which is a repeat of the whole series, is a total scam! So I put the descriptors everywhere I can and I number the books digitally. Consider the order that the series was actually written in:

Blood Knot
 Blood Stone
 Blood Unleashed
 Blood Revealed
 Blood Ascendant

These books are the major novels, the ones with the primary characters in them. These are the books that really move the series story arc along. If you were to skip any of these, you'd be lost if you pick up a later book.

However, between books 1 and 2, lots of readers arm-twisted* me into writing Nial and Sebastian's story—about how they met and how they broke up, which was talked about in the major books, but never shown.

(*Actually, they didn't have to twist my arm very hard at all!)

So I wrote a novella and two short stories dealing with exactly that: Nial and Sebastian's meeting and eventual break-up. In story time, they actually come anywhere between 300 and 60 years before the start of Book 1, *Blood Knot*. However, if I were to place them in the series order according to the time they take place in the series, that would make them the first three stories. If you came to the series cold and read them before you read anything else, you would get a completely wrong impression about the series! Plus, there would be massive spoilers laid down for Book 1, where the real romance takes place and is resolved.

So I placed the shorts between book 1 and 2.

Why between those two and not between, say 2 and 3? Once you have read book 1, you know everything you need to know to be able to read the in-betweeners, plus you wouldn't read any spoilers. You could read the shorts anywhere in the series, really, as long as you've read all the previous major books in the series first.

Here's another example:

Beloved Bloody Time series

1.0: Bannockburn Binding
 1.1: Wait
 2.0: Byzantine Heartbreak
 2.1: Viennese Agreement
 3.0: Romani Armada
 4.0: Spartan Resistance
 5.0: Beloved Bloody Time

As you can see, there are two in-betweeners in this series. *Wait* comes after the first book, because that's all you need to have read to follow and appreciate Lee and Tally's relationship as told in *Wait*. However, *Viennese Agreement* must be read after you've read book 2, *Byzantine Heartbreak*, because you'd get massive spoilers and totally lost, trying to read *Viennese Agreement* without the background *Byzantine Heartbreak* gives you.

Back to the Blood Stone series.

The Blood Stone series:

1:0: Blood Knot
1.5: Amor Meus (Collection)
2.0: Blood Stone
3.0: Blood Unleashed
4.0: Blood Revealed
5.0: Blood Ascendant
5.5: Flesh + Blood (Series boxed set)

I always number a collection or boxed set as x.5 of whatever series they contain, coming after the last story in the bundle.

If you want a shortcut through any series of mine, read all the major books (the x.0 numbered books). Then you can come back later and read the x.x in-betweeners, if you want.

If I've done my job well enough, you should really want to, because the inbetweeners are where all the back story, old romances, break-ups, tragic pasts and more come home to roost. You'll read stories narrated by the characters, too.

Both Nial from the Blood Stone series and Damian from the Stonebrood Saga have related their own stories in these inbetweeners, and a secondary character, Andy, told his own story in *Time Kissed Moments* in the Kiss Across Time series, because readers wanted to know what happened to him.

For all these series that have digital numbering, the order you read the series in is important.

Î have other "series" that are collections of like-minded stories. The Romantic Thriller collection is an example. These books I don't number at all. If I must number them for some reason, I make them all zero: 0.0 *Dead Again*, etc. You could read them in any order you want, skip books, etc., and not trip over any spoilers or lose track of story-lines.

That's how I number series! †

Beloved Bloody Time

A Vampire Ménage Time Travel Futuristic Romance series

Overview

In the early 23rd century, vampires learned how to travel back in time. They created a time-tsunami that threatened life as we know it, until they corrected their mistake. They created the Chronometric Conservation Agency, which is tasked with preserving history and therefore protecting humanity's future. The Touring arm of the Agency offers trips back into the real past, with vampire guides, called travelers.

Now, two hundred years on, vampires are trying to emerge more fully into human society and find complete acceptance, but their attempts stir up enemies, including Psi-filers – genetically modified psychics – who resent the few rights that vampires have already achieved. Time travel comes with its own dangers and difficulties, too.

Love among the annals of history and across time itself...these are the stories of the heroes and heroines of the Agency.

As I mentioned in the numbering section, 1.1 and 2.1 are both in-betweeners. In this case, they're full novellas (i.e. not quite novels).

Related Series and Books

The <u>Kiss Across Time</u> series is the most closely related series to this one – it features vampires and time travel, and MMF ménage romances, just as this one does. However, it is set in contemporary times, rather than in the future.

A Vampire Ménage Urban Fantasy Romance Series

Overview

Nathaniel (Nial) Aquila Valerius Aurelius is over 1,500 years old and a master manipulator of people, hearts and emotions, but he has grown tired of hiding behind masks and he knows the modern world will soon force vampires out of hiding if they do not step out into the light themselves.

But there are those that oppose Nial and his liberators' plans to expose vampires to the world, including the powerful Pro Libertatus, who hide among the powerful of the human world; politicians, military leaders, powerful businessmen and entrepreneurs with enormous resources and manpower to call on to bring Nial and the liberators to heel.

- Print, individual titles: All the stories are available as solo print editions. The individual print titles do not include the interstitial essays that are part of the boxed set. Skip The First Trinity and The Second Trinity, as these are single volume collections of the six novellas.
- Print, collections: The First Trinity, The Second Trinity, and Terra's Victory cover the entire series, but do not include the interstitial essays in the boxed set.
- Ebook, individual titles: All seven primary stories in the series are available as individual ebooks. They do not include the interstitial essays that are in the boxed set.
- Ebooks, collections: The First Trinity, The Second Trinity, and Terra's Victory cover the entire series, but do not include the interstitial essays in the boxed set.
- Ebook series boxed set: Includes everything, including the interstitial essays.

Vistaria is an island nation one hundred miles off the coast of Mexico populated by an Hispanic race, the Vistarians, that enjoy life, food, women and wine. They're an honorable and hardworking race. Vistaria is overshadowed by the threat of rebellion.




